

English courses and Maths

British Sign Language (BSL)

British Sign Language (BSL) is used by approximately 151,000 people in the UK. Learning BSL is a powerful skill which allows you to communicate with deaf colleagues, friends and family.

With the historic passing of the BSL Act in the UK Parliament in 2022, BSL is more visible and celebrated than ever before. Our BSL courses are taught largely by a team of deaf tutors, and we make sure to blend the learning of signs with Deaf Awareness as well as some knowledge of deaf history and culture. Courses are non-accredited so there are no exams – and tutors work hard to make sure you learn in a fun and social environment.

No formal qualifications or previous experience is required for our BSL Beginners 1 and Introductory courses, just an interest in BSL and a willingness to have a go!

British Sign Language – Staff Training for Businesses

Family Learning



Family Learning courses are taught at libraries, Family Hubs, schools, online and in the community.

For parents of children aged 6 months to 3 years, Family Learning deliver courses focused on sensory play, storytime fun, arts and crafts and encourage development of fine motor skills, nutrition, healthy eating and learning through play.

For parents of children aged 4 to 11 years old, we offer courses that are designed around reading, phonics, maths, and English. These courses will support you to understand the journey from Key Stage 1 into Key Stage 2, and from Key Stage 3 into secondary school. We also offer courses that teach you about children's social and emotional wellbeing, resilience, children's

health, First Aid, how to keep your family safe online and budgeting. We also offer courses during school holidays and half terms based around different cultural and local events.

Some courses are delivered as joint learning where you can learn alongside your child, while other courses are for adults only. All Family Learning courses are FREE and specially designed for those who do not currently hold a Level 2 qualification.

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This course exceeded my expectations. My initial goal was to gain knowledge of short games activities to support my daughter however I have learnt more than I expected and it has deepened my understanding of how my daughter is being taught at school. Already we have used games to play at home that my daughter has found useful."

Before enrolling, every individual is offered a one-to-one initial meeting with our specialist coordinators, so that we can identify starting points and goals for the future. This also ensures that the most beneficial and relevant course of learning is chosen and learners have the appropriate support to succeed.

Learning is delivered through practical and engaging

learning activities which encourage learners to be self-advocates, make choices, become more

independent, express opinions and work with others, developing valuable skills that can be transferred outside of the classroom. Learners benefit from a safe, supportive and inclusive learning environment where mutual respect is embedded.

Learners progress to become more confident and independent in their everyday lives and may continue on to further learning, volunteering or employment after attending courses.



Fees and Finance



To view the fees for your courses, visit us online where detailed course information is available for the entire 2024/25 programme or call Freephone 0800 988 0308.

Many GoLearn courses are funded for FREE to all through the Department of Education. Fee paying courses can cost anywhere between £3.30 per hour to £9.90 per hour, depending on the subject.

State Benefits

If you are in receipt of state benefits (such as Job Seeker's Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance and Universal Credit, amongst others) you could be entitled to enrol on your course for FREE, or at the Reduced Fee price.

Earnings Threshold

If your earnings are less than £25,000 (before deductions), you can apply to do an accredited (qualification) course for FREE. Evidence of your income will be required within two weeks of starting the course, and some exclusions apply.

Low-Income

If you are not in receipt of state benefits, but your annual income is below £26,211.90 (before deductions), you may be entitled to pay the Reduced Cost for your course. In some cases, your course may be FREE.

Eligibility for fee reduction is subject to change in line with the Education Skills and Funding Agency's funding rules. Visit us online for up-to-date

Support with costs

At GoLearn, we know that course fees alone are not the only financial costs learners face. Our Discretionary Learner Support Fund (DLSF) is available to help cover the hidden cost of learning like childcare, transport, resources, and exam fees.

You can claim up to £446 (per child) to help cover the cost of childcare whilst you are in class, up to £128 to cover the cost of transport, and up to £64 to cover resources like textbooks and stationery. If your exam fees are not already included in your course costs, you may also be able to use the DLSF to cover this cost.*

Can I pay by instalments?

If your course fees are over £50 you can break the cost of study up into a number of easy payments.

The number of instalments you can pay in varies depending on the amount you need to pay and the length of the course. Any materials and exam fees will need to be paid upfront as part of the first instalment. Instalment plans need to be put in place by our Enrolment team, so if you wish to pay by instalments, please contact us on FREEPHONE 0800 988 0308 or by email at adultlearning@leics.gov.uk to enrol.
