## English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)

Joining ESOL courses with us will help you to improve your quality of life, your ability to carry out everyday tasks independently and be able to acquire a job.

Our ESOL tutors will support you to learn the language skills you need to be able to communicate in English. You will learn vocabulary, grammar and punctuation, reading and writing, and speaking and listening.

By taking our ESOL English courses, you will be able to interact confidently with people in your everyday life, for example, going to the supermarket, organising your banking, or going to the doctor. We have short courses that will develop your skills and create more opportunities for your future. Our courses are a safe and welcoming space for you to learn. You will have a chance to make new friends in class and in the community.

We offer a mix of long and short courses including specialist courses to help you learn the language you need to support your driving theory test, everyday maths and ICT, and work skills

### **How much does my course cost?**

If you meet certain eligibility criteria (i.e., residency status and benefits) then your course could be fully funded, which means there would be no cost to you.

### **How do I find the right course?**

You will need to complete a short assessment to help us measure your level of English. This will allow us to enrol you on a course at the right level. You will also have a chat with a member of our ESOL team, to discuss any concerns you may have, or any learning needs you would like support with. Assessments can be done online or in person at one of our centres.



## ESOL Courses

Course	No. of Weeks	Hours per week	Classroom or online?
English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)	35 weeks	2 x 4 hrs	Both
<p>ESOL courses are available at Entry Level, Level 1, and Level 2. On these courses you will learn English for everyday life, community, and work in the UK. All ESOL courses have 2 sessions per week for 2 hours per session. You will improve speaking, listening, reading and writing skills, be more confident using English and you will take a national examination when ready.</p>			

## Specialist ESOL Courses

These courses are for ESOL learners who need to learn specialist skills for life and work in the UK, alongside the specialist vocabulary.

Course	No. of Weeks	Hours per week	Classroom or online?
ESOL Driving Test Theory	10 weeks	2 hrs	Classroom
<p>For learners that need to improve their English skills for the UK driving theory test.</p>			
ESOL Everyday Maths	25 weeks	2 hrs	Classroom
<p>FREE class leading to a Functional Skills maths qualification. For ESOL learners who have some knowledge of maths but need to improve their skills in everyday use of maths and learn the English needed to take maths exam at entry level.</p>			
ESOL Everyday ICT	8 weeks	2 hrs	Classroom
<p>This course is for ESOL learners who would like to learn computer skills to help them with life and work.</p>			
ESOL Work Skills	10 weeks	2 hrs	Classroom
<p>Do you need extra some extra help with useful words and terms used at work? This short course will cover words often used at work, names of equipment used, how to answer the phone, job search, CVs, application forms, and interviews, this course is for you.</p>
